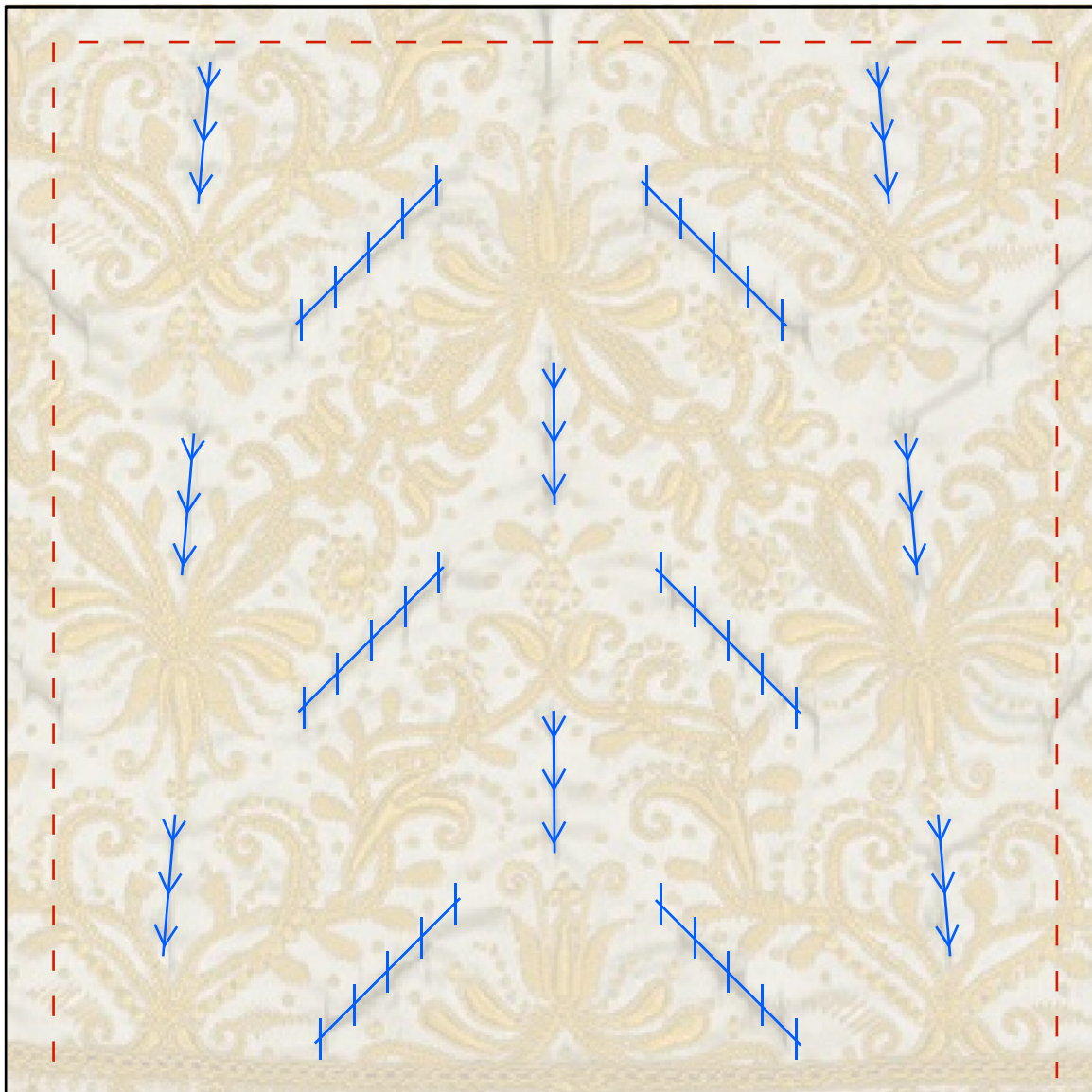


Challenge 5 advanced pinking



V&A Cloak
Place of origin: Italy (made)
Date: 1610-1620 (made)
Materials and Techniques: Silk,
embroidered in silk thread
Museum number: 378-1898
A semi-circular cloak of satin (once
aquamarine, now faded to oyster)
embroidered with yellow silk and
slashed. Lined with yellow silk taffeta.



Challenge 5 advanced pinking

- 1) Baste the two fabric layers (right sides up) together along three sides
- 2) Pin or tape the paper pattern on top
- 3) Slip plastic sheet between the fabric layers and cut all the long straight lines with a small wheel rotary cutter
- 4) Thru the cuts in the paper use a fixon marker to tick the edges of the long cuts for their sideways cuts
- 5) Remove the paper pattern
- 6) With pointed clipping scissors cut the short sideways cuts
