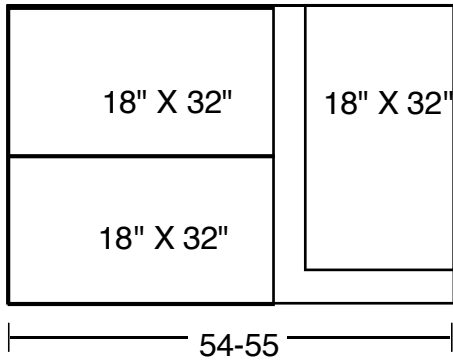
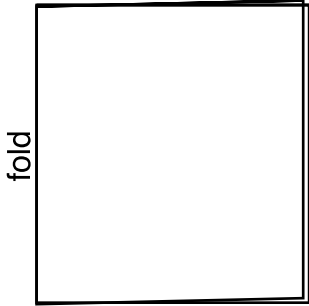


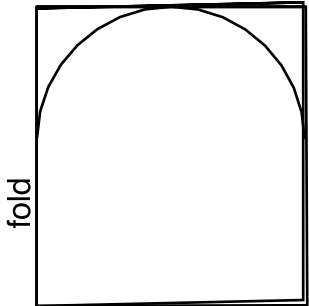
How to make a headbag to protect your garments from getting make-up on them and to protect your hair-do from getting mussed with quick changes of costumes.



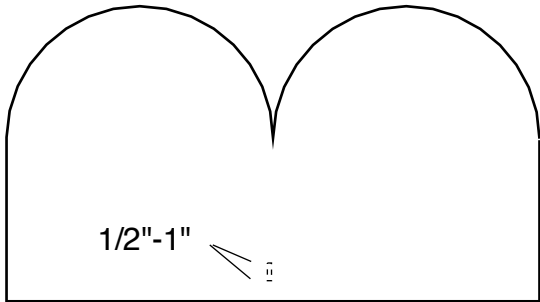
Out of a yard of organza 54-55" wide you can get 3 18" X 32". You can cut or rip. Fold them in half.



Fold them in half.

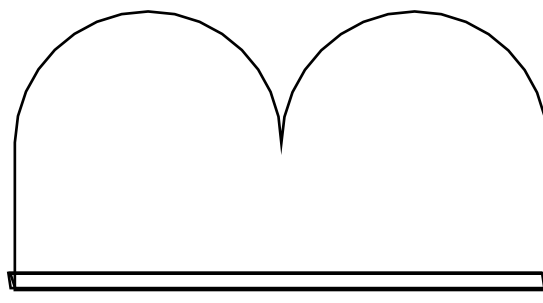
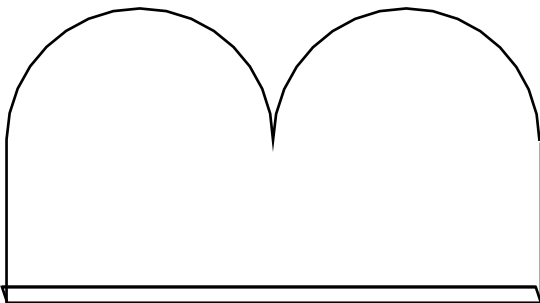
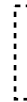


Cut a half round at the top edge.

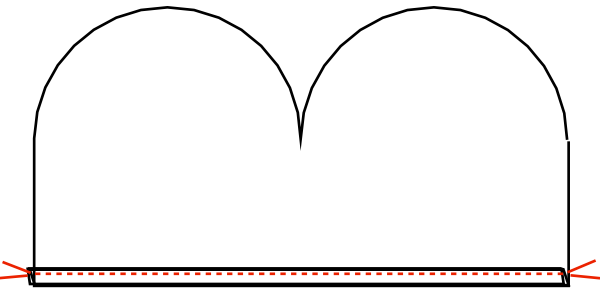


Sew a simple buttonhole along the center line of the fabric from about 1/2" to 1" above the long edge.

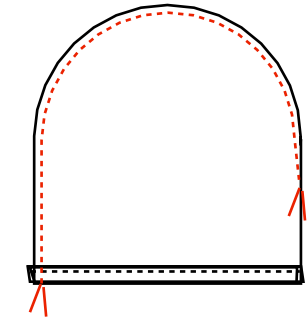
It should be this size.



Press the long straight side up 1/2" twice

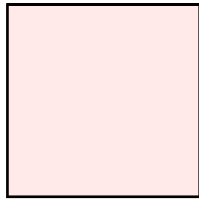


Sew along the folded edge very near the edge.



Fold it in half and sew the open edges with the casing and the buttonhole in the inside. Turn the bag right sides out and use a small safety pin to thread a ribbon thru the casing.



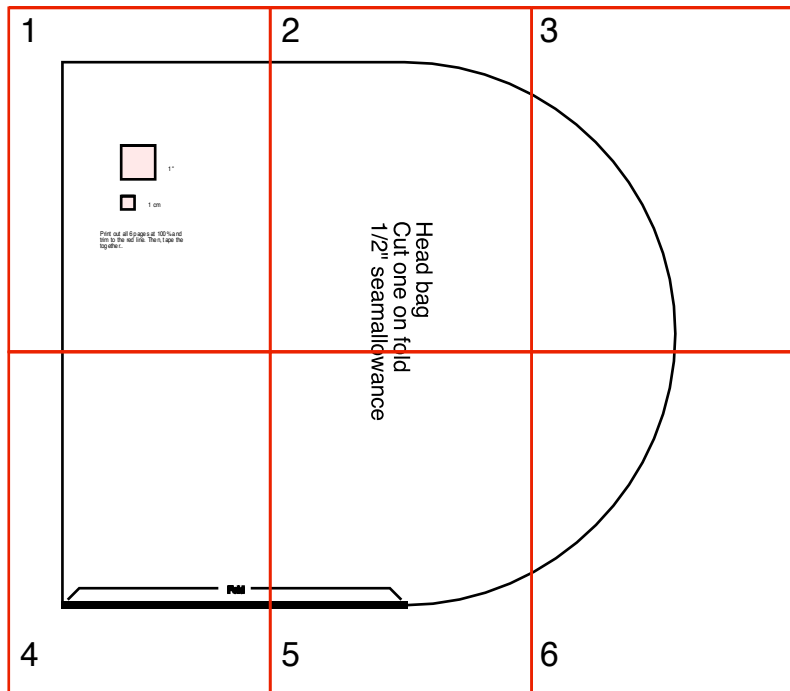




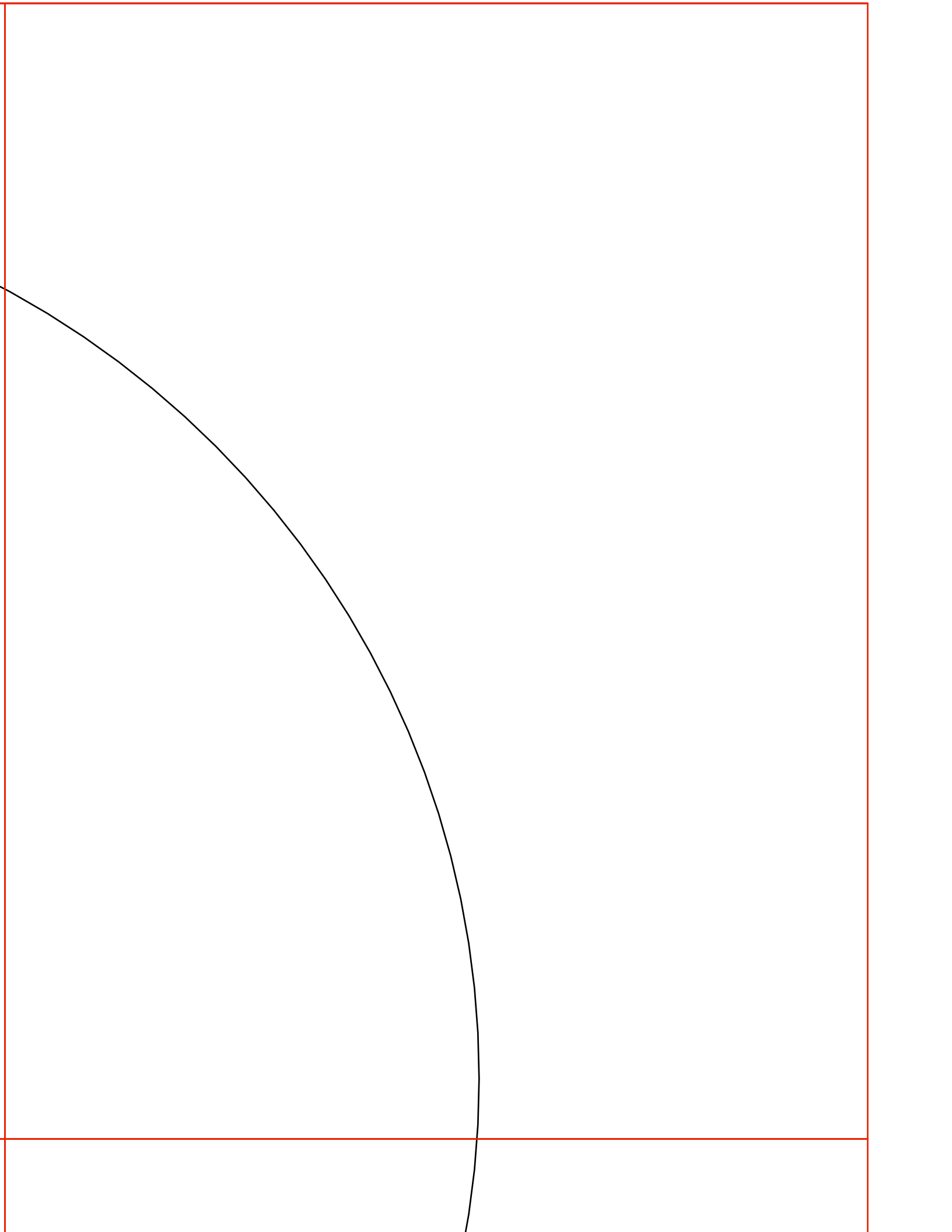
