



Place the sticker over the feather matching up the feathers's stem and the center line of the sticker.




Clip the main stem about 1/2" below the bottom of the sticker.




Pull off the barbs below the botton of the sticker.



Trim the feather up to the edge of the sticker. This is how it looked from the back.






Clip the side indents. Only the lower ones.


Remove the sticker and the "v" shapes will fall out with the sticker.


Take one of your 5" pieces of with and make a "V" bend near the center.



While pinching the feather pinch one half of the wire just past the "V"and twist the other half of the wire with your other hand around the stem of the feather.



Flip it and twist the other half of the wire around the sten as well. Twist the two ends together below the feathers stem. Make sure the feather is secure by trying to gently tug on it.



Cover the wire with florist tape or tissue paper.
